

Sahtu Indigenous Scholarship Program

Helping Sahtu students with the cost of school.

If you're a Sahtu beneficiary living in the Northwest Territories, you may be eligible for a scholarship to help cover your school costs..



Imperial Indigenous Employees National Gathering

Each year, Imperial's Norman Wells operation offers this scholarship to students attending:

- College
- University
- Technical or trade school

You can receive \$5,000 per year to help with:

- Tuition and required school fees
- Textbooks and supplies
- Living expenses during the academic year

You may be eligible to receive this funding for up to four years.

Who can apply?

To be eligible, you:

- Are a Sahtu beneficiary
- Living in the Northwest Territories
- Enrolled as a full-time student in a college or university program in Canada
- Studying in a field connected to the work at Norman Wells (Examples: engineering, geology, geophysics, business, accounting, petroleum technologies, computer science)

Good to know

- You'll need to keep your grades up and stay in school full-time
- You can receive the scholarship for up to 4 years
- You may be considered for summer jobs or full-time work at Norman Wells after graduation

(This isn't guaranteed: hiring depends on job availability and regular hiring processes)

Why this program matters

This scholarship helps Sahtu students build their skills, pursue new opportunities, and plan for a strong future. It's one of the ways Imperial works with communities to support education and long-term careers.

How to apply

Scan the QR code to download the application form. Email it to normanwellscommunity@esso.ca along with the following documents:

- Your most recent school transcripts
- A letter from your Land Corporation or Sahtu Enrolment Office confirming your beneficiary status
- Proof that you are a full-time student



You do not need to send proof of acceptance right away, but you must provide it before we can send your scholarship payment.
