Indigenous education awards program

Since 1994, Imperial's Cold Lake operation provided an educational award for local Indigenous people pursuing higher education.

The award is designed to assist a student throughout their four year degree program, or two year diploma program, with the opportunity to receive up to \$2,500 each year the student is enrolled (up to a maximum of four years).











Eligibility requirements

To be eligible, candidates must:

- Be a resident of Alberta
- Have a high school diploma or a G.E.D.
- Be able to provide proof of acceptance into a post-secondary educational institution in a petroleum industry career path
- Be a registered member of one of the following communities:

- Completed application must be received by Imperial at Cold Lake by June 1
- Recipients must attend their educational institution for one month prior to receiving their award payment
- Must have a Métis or Treaty registration number to apply

Preference will be given to individuals who have graduated from high school in the current year.
