



» In 2014 and 2015, a number of pieces from Imperial's art collection were sold in a series of online and live auctions. The pieces were available through Heffel Fine Art Auction House and provided collectors an opportunity to acquire quality works of fine art at entry-level prices. Response to the auctions was overwhelmingly positive. Net auction proceeds of \$784,000 were disbursed among Imperial's United Way partners across Canada on a pro-rated basis.
