

## Imperial's compliance with requirements under the Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Imperial Oil Limited hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act (Act)* described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 4.1 and 9.1 of the Act, Imperial Oil Limited has deposited with the Minister of Transport, through the online Common Project Search (<a href="http://cps.canada.ca/">http://cps.canada.ca/</a>) and under registry numbers 989, 990, 991 and 992, a description of the following work:

Imperial will be installing four (4) pipeline crossings using a trenchless pipeline construction method. No construction or vehicle access will occur within the ordinary high-water mark.

The proposed crossings will be installed using horizontal directional drilling (HDD) trenchless technology below the watercourses at the following locations:

- Bronte Creek, east of Appleby Line
- Sixteen Mile Creek, south of Lower Base Line
- Humber River, east of Albion Road and south of the Humber River Recreational Trail
- West Humber River, east of Albion Road
